Light in colour and body. Fresh and rustic. Lots of cranberries, red apples and earthy notes! Some might call this wine peculiar, but for advocates of natural wine this is delicious!

2017, 13,5% (V)  
**Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit verdot**  
Ripe plum, stewed black fruits and liquorice dominate, underpinned by pleasing fine, firm tannins and mouth-watering acidity. Great Value!
