Smooth & clean with a pleasing pear juice character

2017, Chenin Blanc, Sauvignon Blanc

Pétillant Naturel wines (aka Pét Nats) are relatively low in alcohol with a lovely light spritz and notes of zesty gooseberry and lime

NV, Pinot Noir, Chardonnay

A blend of Chardonnay & Pinot Noir. Extremally good value wine

A very elegant wine, harmonious & refined with dried fruit accents

Rich & delicate hints of hazelnuts & stone fruits. Long, toasty & complex wine from 'Champagne's finest year'

Extraordinary depth & freshness, with delicious red berry flavours

Loire, Coteaux du Layon, Pithon Paillé £19.99 2015, Chenin Blanc (Half Bottle)

Flavours of glazed fruits, pears & subtle notes of quince; Les 4 Vents showcases the best of botrytis affected Chenin

Bordeaux, Sauternes, Clos Dady £20.49

2014, Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon (Half Bottle)
A highly complex wine, enticing you with scents of lime, acacia, apricots, grilled almond & honey

Pineau des Charentes, Drouineau £22.99

A fortified white wine to which a Cognac eau-de-vie is added & then matured, giving a brandy-like edge to this drink's alluring sweetness

Muscat de Saint-Jean-de-Minervois,
Domaine de Barroubio £23.99

2017, Muscat Blanc à Petits Grains

Fortified wine with an intense, complex nose of grapes, pear, rose petals & citrus. A sweet & powerfully rich palate

Alsace, Vendage Tardive, Trimbach (VE) £25.49/£41.99 2015, Gewurztraminer (Half Bottle or Full Bottle)

Lychee, brown spices, mint and honey toy with one another in this late harvest Gewurtztraminer. A lush, decadently sweet wine

Red Pineau des Charentes £28.99

Fortified red wine to which a Cognac eau-de-vie is added & then matured for 5 years in oak barrels

Sud-Ouest, Château du Cèdre, Camille £10.49 2018, Malbec

This Malbec is all about pure fruit with no oak aging. Medium bodied with a jammy, spicy, rounded finish

Sud-Ouest, Aramis, Famille Laplace (VE) £10.49 2016, Tannat 60%, Syrah 30%, Cabernet Franc 10%

This is a soft, ripe & fruity wine. It has a juicy blackberry flavour, plenty of acidity & a soft smooth aftertaste

Bordeaux, Château Oueyret-Pouillac

2014, Merlot 61%, Cabernet Sauvignon 22%, Cabernet Franc 17% A fruity, Merlot-led Bordeaux Supérieur; well rounded tannins keep it incredibly food friendly

Rhône, Les Vignerons d'Estezargues) £11.99 2018. Grenache. Syrah

A natural, unfiltered Cotes-du-Rhône; gutsy, full-bodied & packed with the bright red fruit flavours typical of the region. A wonderful introduction to France's natural wines

A sun-soaked biodynamic Merlot from the Southern Rhone. Soft, round & inviting with lots of juicy black & red fruits

2017, Gamay

Elegant & fresh with lots of fruit & little tannin; a solid introduction to this region & it's most famed grape

Languedoc, Maison de la Villette 2017, Pinot Noir

A prime example of the South of France's Pinot Noir. Refreshing and subtle aromas of ripe raspberries & cranberries with hints of plum & a touch of toast

2016, Merlot 55%, Syrah 25%, Cab. Sav. 10%, Grenache 10% A beautiful example of Southern French grape varieties; ripe red fruit & spicy flavours full of Southern warmth

A more natural approach to Southern Rhône winemaking; stewed fruits & earthy spices are supported by subtle hints of savoury herbs

Aromas of red berries and spice dominate the nose, with a fresh, fruity & moreish palate

Languedoc, St Chinian, Thierry Navarre (VE) £16.49 2016, Carignan, Cinsault, Grenache Noir, Syrah

Remarkably nuanced wine; fresh & aromatic yet boldly bodied & structured, offering black plum, cherry & a touch of red pepper

Jura, Arbois, Daniel Dugois (VE) 2014, Trousseau

A light bodied red from a greatly underappreciated region in Eastern France. Plentiful flavours of red fruit, currants & gentle spice

A fantastic example of youthful Syrah's potential. Raspberry & black pepper dominate the nose, supported by fine tannins that help the wine feel sumptuous & complete without being weighty

Beaujolais, Fleurie, Pierre-Marie Chermette £20.99 2017, Gamay

All about pure fruit expression; black cherry, plum & citrus. Silky, approachable tannins keep this wine as food-friendly as it is quaffable

Rhône, Vacqueyras, La Garrigue

2015, Grenache 75%, Syrah/Mourvèdre/Cinsault 25%

Sumptuous spicy fruit flavours typical of the South of France. Rich, with powerful but well integrated tannins. Tremendous wine for food

Sud-Ouest, Cahors, Château du Cèdre (VE) Bottle £21.49

2015, Malbec 90%, Tannat/Merlot 10%

Magnum £44.99

An excellent example of a classics Malbec. Ripe with spicy blackcurrant flavours; the tannins are balanced perfectly by rich layers of fruit

Languedoc, Pic Saint Loup, Foulaquier (VE) £21.99 2017, Syrah 50% & Grenache 50%

Heavily concentrated wine; rich, dark fruit flavours are balanced by subtle savoury characteristics & a stony minerality.

Bordeaux, St. Emilion Grand Cru,

Château La Croix Chantecaille

2013, Merlot 80%, Cabernet Franc 20%

A fine Grand Cru packed with notes of ripe black fruit & pine, with a diverse savoury palate & woody tannins

Auvergne, No Control, Magma Rock (VE) 2017, Gamay

Unique natural wine from the Auverge region. A distinctive nose with notes of volcanic rock is offset by a bright & lightly effervescent palate

Concentrated flavour of red cherry fruit & a hint of earthy minerality. A great example of Burgundy wines

Rhône, Châteauneuf du Pape, Chante Cigale £29 99 2016, Grenache 65%, Syrah 20%, Mourvèdre 10%, Cinsault 5% A wonderful nose of spice & dark fruits, with a rich & ripe palate underpinned by very fine tannins

£32.99 Bourgogne, Mercurey Premier Cru, Michel Juillot "Clos des Barraults" 2014, Pinot Noir

It infuses the palate with its lingering jammy finish and has aromas of cherry & red currant with a woody finish

Bordeaux, Margaux, Château Paveil de Luze 2012, Cabernet Sauvignon 65%, Merlot 30%, Cabernet Franc 5% Offering a generous bouquet of ripe fruits, this Margaux has a silky & seductive palate with vanilla, toast & blackberry on the finish

Bourgogne, Nuits-Saint-Georges, Henri Gouges £42.99 2014, Pinot Noir

One of the top producers in Burgundy. Fantastic structure, with notes of blackberry, raspberry & a hint of black tea

Bourgogne, Gevrey Chambertin, En Jouise (VE) £51.99 **Domaine Harmand Geoffroy**

2014, Pinot Noir

Splendidly rich & fresh, offering endless juicy fruit on the palate. Softtextured, with great persistence of flavour

Bordeaux, Lalande de Pomerol,

Magnum £53.49

2004, Merlot 90%, Cabernet Franc 10% Spice, leather, and chocolate notes typical of Bordeaux combine with lush fruit and silky tannins to provide depth and layers of flavor

An amazing Côte Rôtie exhibiting intense flavours of blackcurrant & vanilla, balanced by roasted notes

2012, Cabernet Sauvignon 59%, Merlot 36%, Cabernet Franc 5% A marvellous array of flavours & aromas, notably blackcurrants, wild berries, leather, chocolate, vanilla, smoky oak & spices

Crisp gooseberry flavours and a fruity nose that will delight any sauvignon blanc drinker; the presence of chardonnay balances the sauvignon's acidity with a creamy texture

Sud-Ouest, Pacherenc Sec, Odé d'Aydie, £16.49 Famille Laplace

2016, Petit & Gros Manseng

A powerful & complex wine with scents of lemon & grapefruit, harmoniously balanced by notes of vanilla & honey

Sud-Ouest, Gaillac, Domaine d'Escausses (VE) £16.99 2015, Sauvignon Blanc 50%, Mauzac, Muscadelle 50%

This Gaillac is unique for its oak aging; dried fruit flavours lead into a moreish, dry finish

Bourgogne, Prémeaux, Hautes-côtes de Nuits £18.49 2015, Chardonnay

An organic wine, rich and easy to drink. It has buttery aromas finishing with hints of grapefruit and lemon

Loire, Château Thebaud, Muscadet Granit £19.99 2013, Melon de Bourgogne

Four years lees-aging at minimum gives flavours of honey & quince with notes of brioche bread & dried fruits

Loire, Sancerre, Vignoble Dauny (VE) £19.99 2018, Sauvignon Blanc

The Dauny family converted their vineyards to organic farming practices decades ago, ensuring longevity in the quality of their land, grapes, and wine. Typical Sancerre qualities dominate, with great acidity and just a hint of green plum

Loire, Anjou, Mozaik, Pithon Paillé (VE) £19.99 2017. Chenin Blanc

A fresh, dry Chenin; white fruits mingle with notes of straw, honey & flowers, leading to a zesty, mineral finish

Loire, Pouilly Fumé, Château Favray £19.99 2018. Sauvignon Blanc

Starting with an aromatic fruity bouquet & finishing with clean, crisp citrus style fruit. Great length & mineral tones

Gateshead, The Winery, Laneberg Wine £20.49 2018 Bacchus

The only non-French wine we serve, from our neighbouring city Gateshead. Fantastic length, with elderflower aromas & zesty flavours of green apple that will be familiar to Sauvignon drinkers

2017. Chasselas

Natural wine with keen acidity & great fruit expression. Flavours of mirabelle plum & dried banana are highlighted by a gentle, fresh effervescence & an incredibly floral nose

Medium bodied chardonnay with crisp apple acidity & pure fruit flavours with white peache & pears, ending with a classic dry finish

Deliciously golden in colour, offering an exotic bouquet of lavender, honey, sweet grape & marzipan, with an enticingly soft mouth-feel

Rhône, Domaine Roche Audran, Cuvée César £21.99 2015, Grenache Blanc, Viognier

Offering big flavours of ripe fruits & lemon with a subtle note of toast

Alsace, Riesling Réserve, Trimbach £21.99 2018, Riesling

Tremendous Riesling from one of The French Quarter's favourite winemakers; youthful freshness coupled with ample complexity ensure every vintage is an utter delight

Ripe citrus & stone fruits with a creamy texture & a hint of toast on the finish; tremendous white Bordeaux from one of the most famed families

Medium gold in colour offering complex aromas of lychee & lemon with mouth filling flavours of tropical fruit & a hint of smoke

Sud-Ouest, Irouléguy, Domaine Arretexea (VE) £33.99 2016, Gros Manseng 50%, Petit Manseng 40%, Petit Courbu 10% This biodynamic white reveals wildly aromatic notes of tropical fruits, pineapple & melon. Offers a wonderfully balanced acidity & minerality

Bourgogne, Puligny-Montrachet, Alain Chavy 2015, Chardonnay

This Puligny is bursting with ripe tropical fruit characters, balanced by a concentrated limey acidity & spicy oak. An outstanding Chardonnay

World class Riesling. Alsatian winemaking at its best; delicate yet intense, with remarkable complexity. Drinks excellently today but would comfortably age another 5 years in your collection
